

# **National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University**

## **Implementation Regulations for Graduate Student Scholarships and Grants**

Approved at the 5th Administrative Meeting of the 2022–2023 Academic Year on February 22, 2023

- Article 1 National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (hereinafter NYCU) hereby formulates the Implementation Regulations for Graduate Student Scholarships and Grants (hereafter the Regulations) in accordance with the Ministry of Education Regulations for Tuition and Fee Collection at Junior Colleges and Institutions of Higher Education. The purpose of the Regulations is to encourage exceptional performance among students, enable them to complete their studies with peace of mind, and motivate them to participate in on-campus teaching and other services.
- Article 2 Only current students, excluding in-service program students, are eligible for graduate student scholarships.
- Article 3 The scholarships and grants as described in the Regulations are divided into scholarships, grants, and labor-based remuneration for part-time assistants, all of which can be earned simultaneously by a student.
1. Scholarships and grants are used to reward outstanding graduate students and support those with economically disadvantages. They do not involve the responsibilities and considerations of employment relationships and are not remuneration for labor.
  2. Labor-based remuneration for part-time assistants is provided to students who participate in teaching or other services of the colleges, departments, institutes, and degree programs of NYCU as teaching assistants, administrative assistants, research assistants, or in other part-time roles.
- Article 4 A given amount of the total tuition and fee revenue of NYCU and its other funding sources shall be set aside each year for graduate student scholarships and grants, with the funding budget subject to revisions in accordance with the revenue status for a given year.
- Article 5 All colleges and departments of NYCU shall formulate their own regulations for implementing graduate student scholarships and grants, including the standards and quotas for scholarships, grants, and labor-based remuneration for part-time assistants.
- Article 6 The funding of the scholarships and grants for each college shall include the expenses pertaining to labor and health insurance, labor pension, severance pay, and other expenses borne by the employer.
- Article 7 To safeguard the learning and labor rights of the students of NYCU, the regulations formulated by all colleges and departments shall comply with the Ministry of Education Guidelines for Safeguarding the Rights and Interests of Scholarship and Financial Aid Recipients in College of Above, Ministry of Labor Guiding Principles for Safeguarding the Labor Rights and Benefits of Part-time Assistants in the Tertiary Education, and the relevant guidelines and regulations of NYCU.
- Article 8 The Regulations and any amendments thereto shall take effect upon their approval at an Administrative Meeting.
