

Regulations Governing the Establishment of NYCU Dormitory Management Committee

Modified during the first semester Meeting of Student Affairs of 110 academic year dated on Dec. 03, 2021

One. In order to strengthen the management of the student dormitories and provide a comfortable dormitory environment for students, the Student Dormitory Management Committee of Yang Ming campus (hereinafter referred to as “the Yang Ming Dormitory Management Committee”) and the Student Dormitory Management Committee of Chiao Tung campus (hereinafter referred to as “the Chiao Tung Dormitory Management Committee”) are established in accordance with Article 23 of the University Organizational Charter, can hold meetings individually to formulate the student accommodation policy and its management regulations of their respective campuses.

Two. Member Organization

I. Yang Ming Dormitory Management Committee

1. Governing Matters:

- (1) Review and modification of the organization constitution of the Student Dormitory Management Committee.
- (2) Review and modification of the terms and conditions of the student dormitories fees.
- (3) Review and modification of the regulations concerning the dormitory assignments, management, etc. of the student dormitories.
- (4) Review of all other matters concerning the management of the student dormitories.

2. There will be one convener, who will be served or assigned by the Vice President for Student Affairs or Dean of Student Affairs. One Executive Secretary, who will be served by the Division Head of the Housing Center of Yang Ming campus. One Secretary, who will be served concurrently by the business undertaker, will be held responsible for arranging the agenda and preparing relevant materials.

3. Permanent Member of Committee: the convener, the Executive Secretary, and one each of the unit heads or representatives from “Military Education Office and Health Center” etc. on Yang Ming campus.

4. Selected Member of the Committee: comprised of one professor representative recommended by respective departments on Yang Ming campus, four student representatives from the Yang Ming Branch of Student Union (including two graduate students, two undergraduate students), three cadres of the Student Dormitory Self-Government Association (representatives appointed by each dormitory head) with a one-academic-year term, and can be re-elected.

II. Chiao Tung Dormitory Management Committee

1. Governing Matters:

- (1) Review and modification of the organization constitution of the Student Dormitory Management Committee.
- (2) Review and modification of the terms and conditions of the student dormitories fees.
- (3) Review and modification of the regulations concerning the dormitory assignments, management, etc. of the student dormitories.
- (4) Review of all other matters concerning the management of the student dormitories.

2. There will be one convener, who will be served or assigned by the Vice President for Student Affairs or Dean of Student Affairs. One Executive Secretary, who will be served by the Division Head of the 2nd Housing Center of Chiao Tung campus. One Secretary, who will be served concurrently by the business undertaker, will be held responsible for arranging the agenda and preparing relevant materials.

3. Permanent Member of Committee: the convener, the Executive Secretary, and one each of the unit heads or representatives from “Military Education Office and Health Center” etc. on Chiao Tung campus.
4. Selected Member of the Committee: comprised of one professor representative recommended by respective departments on Chiao Tung campus, ten student representatives from the Chiao Tung Branch of Student Union (at least two graduate student representatives), with a one-year term.

III. All members of the Committee will be sent separately by the Housing Centers of Yang Ming campus and Chiao Tung campus to be appointed by the principal at the beginning of each school year.

- Three. Meeting of the Dormitory Management Committee for each of both campuses shall at least be held once in each semester, and extra meetings can be held by the Chairman of the Committee when necessary, or with over 1/3 signatures of the members. The meeting may invite related persons to attend the meeting.
- Four. This Regulation is passed by the Meeting of Student Affairs and will be enforced after the approval of the principal of the university. The modification hereof shall proceed in accordance with the same procedures.
